The ordinary book on first aid does not answer the purpose, for the ordinary book on first aid contains nothing on ship sanitation, little on hygiene as applicable on board ship, nothing regarding maritime quarantine, and is only sufficient in scope to enable the reader to render first aid while awaiting the arrival of the doctor, who, on land, is usually within a few minutes or at most a few hours call of the...
