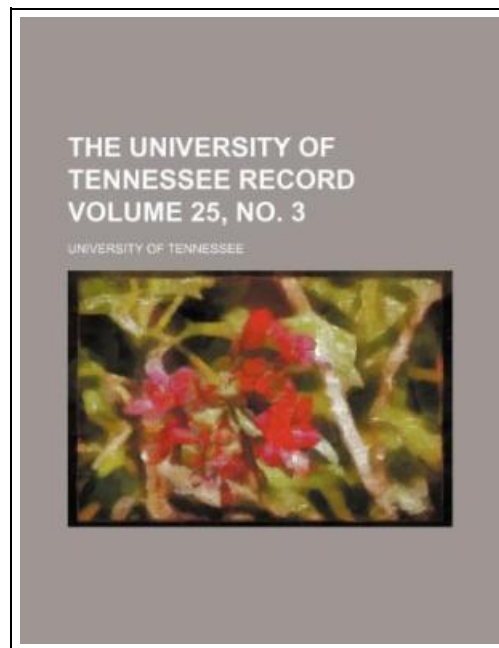

The Southern Appalachian Coal Operators Association contributes Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars per year for two years to be used for a fellowship in the College of Engineering for coal investigation. 2 The American Limestone Company gives Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars to the College of Engineering for the study of dolomitic charts in concrete work. 3. As evidence of its appreciation of the outstanding work of the Experiment Station, the National Lime Association gives Eighteen Hundred Dollars per year for five years, to be used in soil fertility studies in relation to lime. The South-East Lime Association supplements this fund with a donation of Fifteen Hundred Dollars and Mr. Alfred Cowles of Sewaren, New Jersey, contributes Three Hundred Dollars to provide additional facilities for the work. 4. Mr. E. R. Lutz, of the class of 1912, gives Twelve Hundred Dollars to be used as a loan fund for Liberal Arts students resident in Tennessee, in memory of his father, J. E. Lutz, long a prominent business man of Knoxville. This gift may well be considered an indication of the interest our more recent graduates take in the wellbeing of their Alma Mater. 5. The same spirit of love and loyalty inspires the class of 1922, who graduate today, in their gift of Five Hundred Dollars as a student loan fund 6.
